Dear Student & Parent/Carer

As you will know, this year schools were asked to supply Centre Assessed Grades, for the exam board to use when awarding final examination grades. Initially this would lead to some differences between the Centre Assessed Grades and the calculated grades allocated by the exam board. However, following the Education Minister's announcement yesterday, the grade awarded will now be the higher grade of either the Centre Assessed Grade or the exam board calculated grade.

If you were entered for a re-sit then the final grade you will be awarded will be the highest grade out of the Centre Assessed Grade, calculated grade or re-sit.

If you have just completed year 12 or year 13 last year, you will already have collected your results. If the exam board calculated a grade that was higher than the Centre Assessed Grade, then this higher grade will stand. If the exam board awarded a grade lower than the Centre Assessed grade, then the Centre Assessed Grade will stand.

Your updated results will be sent to you in the post as soon as they are released by the exam board.

This will mean the exam board will not accept any appeal to your grade as you are receiving the higher grade. However, if you believe an administrative error has been made, please e-mail Miss Reynolds, Exams & Data Manager on reynoe@lewisgirls.caerphilly.sch.uk.
